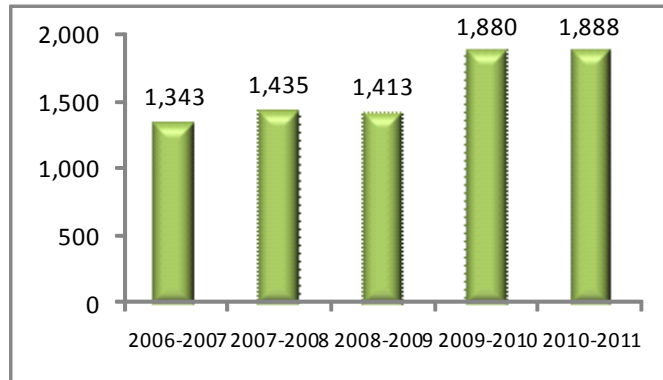

Part A: State of the Environment over time

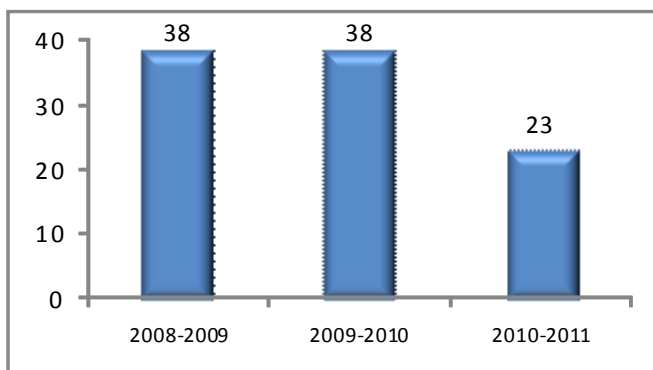
Aboriginal heritage sites listed within the LGA

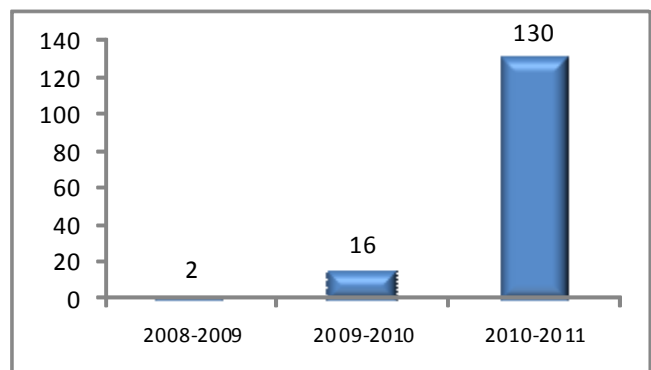

Part D: Comments

Aboriginal Heritage sites are managed by the state and commonwealth governments. Council employs an Aboriginal Community Development Officer to promote the participation of aboriginal people in local area decision making and service provisions. In 2010 this Officer commenced aboriginal awareness training which is being undertaken by all employees as well as other government agencies.

Note: The proportion of the Council workforce that is Aboriginal was 2.5% - less than the proportion of the LGA population (3.8%).
