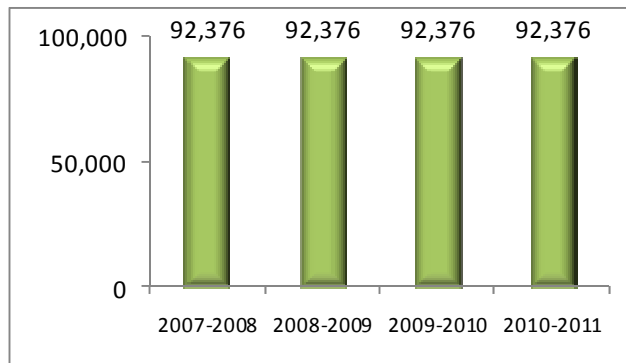


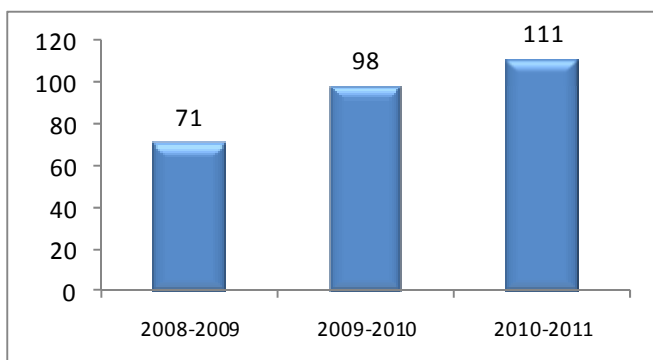
Part A: State of the Environment over time

(including acid sulphate, flooding, contamination, endangered ecological communities) (ha)

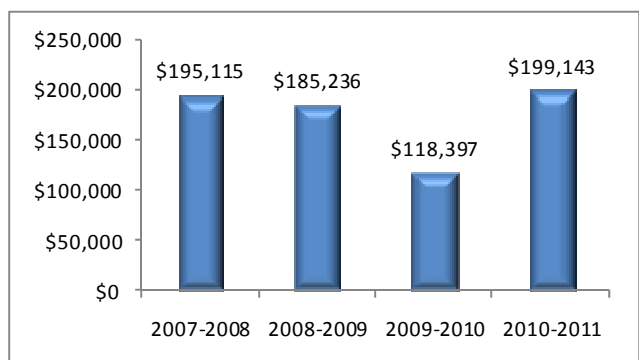


Part B: Council response
