

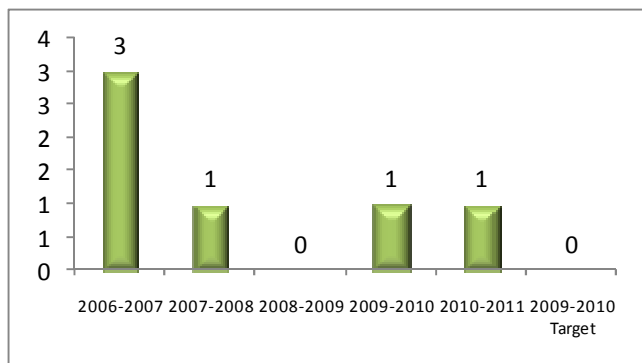

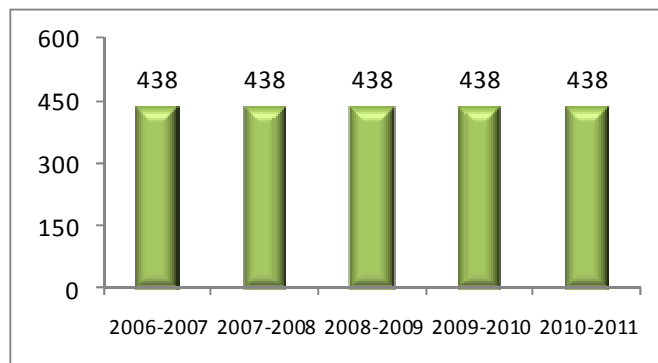

Non-Aboriginal listed heritage items demolished or destroyed

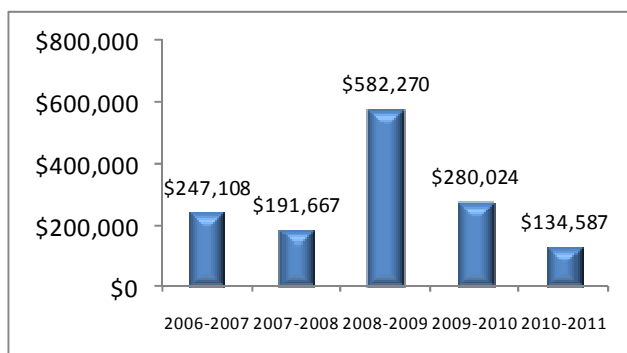


Non-Aboriginal heritage sites identified or listed for protection in the LEP
