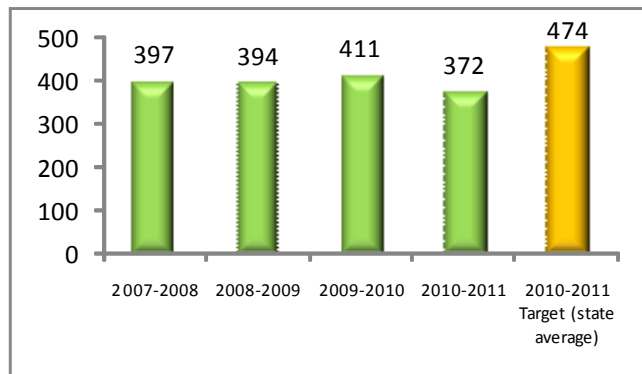
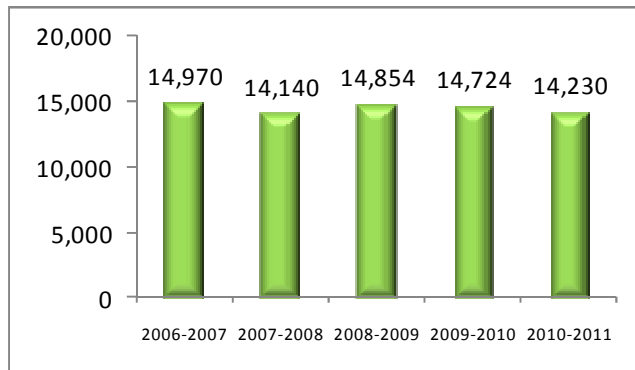


Part A: State of the Environment over time

Residential water consumption per residential connection per day (litres)

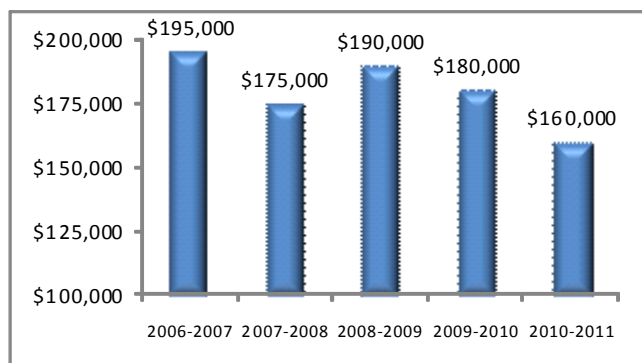


LGA water sourced (megalitres)

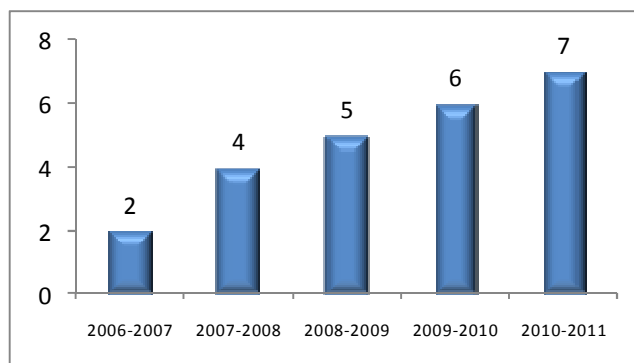

Water consumption per resident and total water consumption across the city decreased substantially over the 2010/11 reporting period. This can be attributed to the above average rainfall experienced over the year reducing the need for residents to water gardens or draw on Council's supply to fill water tanks in non reticulated areas.
